



1 Select the area that you are travelling to, the dates that you leave and get back to Australia. The max no of students we can insure on one policy is 25. If you have more than this, obtain 2 quotes always ensuring that there is an adult on the policy. This ensures that you get half price for the students. If you want an indicative quote, select 1 adult (18-55). Students will be half this price

3 Snow Sports - If the group is on a dedicated snow sports trip then you need to enter the relevant dates when participating. If the trip is where students are staying at family homes, then there is automatically up to 8 days snow sports cover included and there is no need to enter dates.
Excess - There is also an option to delete the excess which is \$135. The excess is the first part of a claim which is paid by the insured. If you select this option, all persons on the policy will need to take it.
